



7TH AND FINAL SEASON OF “GILMORE GIRLS” MAKES ITS CABLE PREMIERE ON ABC FAMILY STARTING JUNE 8

Seasons Four Through Seven Also to Air in HD for First Time on Network

Burbank, CA (May 12, 2009) – “Gilmore Girls” fans can relive the final chapter of their favorite mother-daughter duo when the seventh and final season of the series premieres on ABC Family on **Monday, June 8** (5:00 – 6:00 PM ET/PT). Now airing all seven seasons of the hit WB show, ABC Family will present Seasons Four through Seven of the series in HD for the first time on cable television.
